

Vaccine Reluctancy

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“No Right to Refuse”

- ▶ On 17th January 2019 the WHO while unveiling its new 5 year strategic plan, The 13th Global Programme of Work, declared **vaccine hesitancy among global public health threats alongside Ebola**. On 21st March 2019 in a meeting at Geneva to decide the post 2020 vaccine strategy, it talked of deep and broad engagement of stakeholders to take forward the vaccination agenda globally and Kate Gilmore, UN Dy High Commissioner Human Rights, stated, **“There is no such thing as the right to refuse vaccines.”**

Why the term “vaccine hesitancy”?

- ▶ Vaccine rejection is a better term
- ▶ However this has stronger connotations
 - Might provoke the public to think
 - Might make the healthcare workers feel that tackling the issue is hopeless
- ▶ The term vaccine hesitancy is chosen because
 - It projects the notion of ill educated people being on the fence
 - It makes the healthcare sector feel that only a few doubts need to be cleared
 - The chosen answers to those doubts are provided
 - But very often the vaccine is projected as the only alternative
 - Not taking it is deemed an irresponsible behaviour
 - The subject can be vaccinated despite objections for the “greater good”

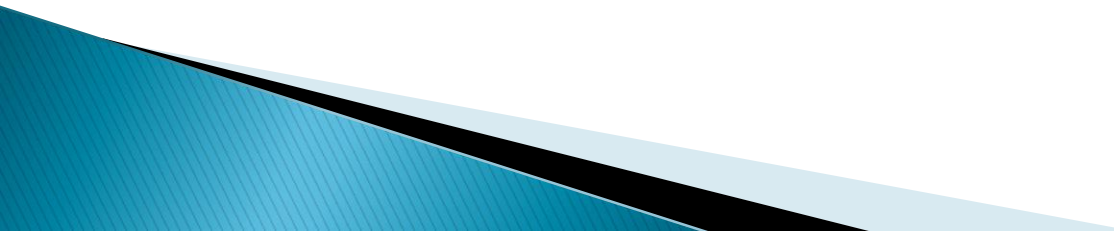
Vaccine reluctance

- ▶ Globally vaccine rejection rate is high
- ▶ Kaiser Family Foundation Survey (Feb 2021) in Kentucky, USA 51% of population were found reluctant to take the Covid vaccines
- ▶ In hospital surveys 60 to 70% of the doctors were found reluctant to take recommended vaccines (influenza, Hep B) citing adverse effects as the cause
- ▶ Among hcw in Palestine, “The intention to get vaccinated was only 37.8%, while 31.5% were undecided, and 30.7% planned to refuse it.
- ▶ A study in France found <60% of auxiliary nurses and attendants willing to take the Covid vaccines
- ▶ In India coercive tactics were applied to vaccinate healthcare workers who were wary of the Covid jab

Why are people vaccine reluctant?

- ▶ Vaccine reluctance is about **mistrust** in the system stemming from personal or observed **harm from vaccines** leading to people probing the process and finding **yawning gaps**.
- ▶ The key issues are;
 - Harm from vaccines ignored (1345 published scientific studies in Pubmed discuss vaccine link with 404 diseases and disorders including death)
 - Lack of strong supervision and regulation
 - Regulating agencies in bed with industry. “Asleep at the switch”
 - Vaccine push by industry and lobbyists. Once set in motion the Jaggernaut never stops
 - Vaccine manufacturers provided legal immunity (USA)
 - Absolute lack of informed consent
 - Victims left to fend for themselves, mocked at, threatened
 - Censoring of dissident opinion even if by highly educated medical professionals. “Only one view is right”
 - Vaccine controversies are hushed up
 - **Result: Mistrust in the system**


Categories of the vaccine reluctant

- ▶ People wanting stricter rules and regulations, honesty and integrity in implementing them, removal of legal indemnity for the manufacturers, and a robust system of adverse events tracking and reporting, coupled with compensation and treatment protocols for those dead and injured
 - ▶ Those who want safe vaccines without the harmful adjuvants and other objectionable and toxic ingredients in vaccines
 - ▶ People who have religious objections to vaccines using human aborted fetal cells and use of animal serum and cells in vaccines, animal gelatine from cow, pigs
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Categories...

- ▶ People who wish the freedom to choose which vaccines to take or give to their children. They also want a larger interval between shots and single vaccines per visit than more than one vaccine administered in one visit
- ▶ People who are fence sitters. They obey the vaccine schedule but are suspicious and are studying the controversies to know the truth for themselves
- ▶ People who do not want any vaccines at all as they are either vaccine injured or have vaccine injured members in their family. Having looked at the impacts first hand they are wary of the shots

Categories....

- ▶ People who are against vaccines because they understand health and do not subscribe to the mainstream view of disease and therefore feel vaccines are more about inducing chronic disease than about any prevention
 - ▶ Those that are anti vaccine because they have researched the science and politics behind vaccines and concluded it is a clear threat to health
 - ▶ People who reject vaccines because they are rights conscious and they feel the state and the pharmaceutical industry should not dictate their choice of treatment or what should be injected into their bodies
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Are vaccines scientific?

- ▶ In 1942 Dr Karl Landsteiner and Dr Merrill Chase published their findings on cellular immunity which proved only the natural infection cycle can provide immunity. Scientifically the concept of vaccines died with that study.
- ▶ In trials vaccines are not tested against genuine placebos but against another vaccine or same vaccine minus the antigen
- ▶ Vaccines have led to the Th1 Th2 immune imbalance that predisposes the body to chronic disease
- ▶ Vaccines lead to autoimmune inflammatory immunotoxic conditions and can cause all the chronic diseases observed in society today
- ▶ Infants and children are vaccinated despite the fact that they can produce antibodies only at the age of 5 to 7 when the immune system is formed
- ▶ Studies on cancer reveal that those who undergo the experience of acute diseases in childhood do not develop chronic diseases and cancers later in life. What are we preventing?

The Covid Vaccine Coercion

- ▶ Vaccines developed at warp speed based upon incomplete unprecedented parallel trials of 8 months. The physical trials end in 2023
- ▶ Emergency authorization use vaccines cannot be mandated, yet Govt circulars are imposing vaccines on people. Supreme Court orders ignored
- ▶ **NO INFORMED CONSENT** that is vital for such use. No transparency, no accountability
- ▶ They employ new technology and new ingredients whose long term impacts are not known
- ▶ Have taken more than 40,000 lives in Europe, USA, and UK. Range of adverse effects frightening
- ▶ Reluctance to record adverse effects/ breakthrough cases
- ▶ Efforts to complete vaccine targets before formal approval
- ▶ Pressure on FDA to approve Pfizer vaccine
