The Public Health Bill 2017/2022 – Analyses, Implications And Reasons Not To Pursue Such Bills, Because They Are Ultra Vires Of The Constitution Of India

Dear Sir,

We would like to bring to your attention that the aforementioned Bill and its content have serious implications on the rights of citizens as enshrined in the Indian Constitution. We, the undersigned, would like to place on record our objections and recommendations through this letter.

This Bill is violative of **Article 14, 19 and 21** of the Constitution of India. It is against the law of Informed Consent as has been laid down by the Government of India under **Disaster Management Act, 2005** itself. This Bill is draconian, gives sweeping powers to unknown and unaccountable individuals and institutions. This Bill also couples itself with the proposed Pandemic Treaty of the WHO. The WHO is an unelected Body and its provisions would also be Ultra Vires of the Indian Constitution.

We submit a clause-by-clause analysis of the Public Health Bill. Based on this analysis, we demand, the Bill must be withdrawn. Our demand is based on the following conclusions:

- 1. Role of State governments has been diminished. In fact, all democratic, Constitution-recognised elected bodies have been made infructuous through this Bill.
- 2. Terms used in the Bill lack <u>precise definition</u>, <u>giving scope for dangerous open-ended interpretations</u>, which provide potential for significant misuse.
- 3. Bill does not explain nor define what problem is to be solved through its enactment.
- 4. Undefined and open ended clauses in the Bill can create new kinds of problems.
- 5. No institutionalised authority has been defined or identified to implement the provisions in this Bill.
- 6. This Bill does not pave a responsible path for the protection of public health, especially, in the terminology used in this Bill, as if these are management measures.

We furthermore, bring to your attention that the Public Health (Prevention, Control And Management Of Epidemics, Bio-Terrorism And Disasters) Bill, 2017 and a 2022 version of it are not in the public domain, which is also not in accordance with India's Parliamentary processes. We therefore, appeal to you as the Hon'ble Health Minister, to take due note of the grave implications of this PHB and request you to make a Public Statement guaranteeing withdrawal of this Bill in its entirety and forthwith.
